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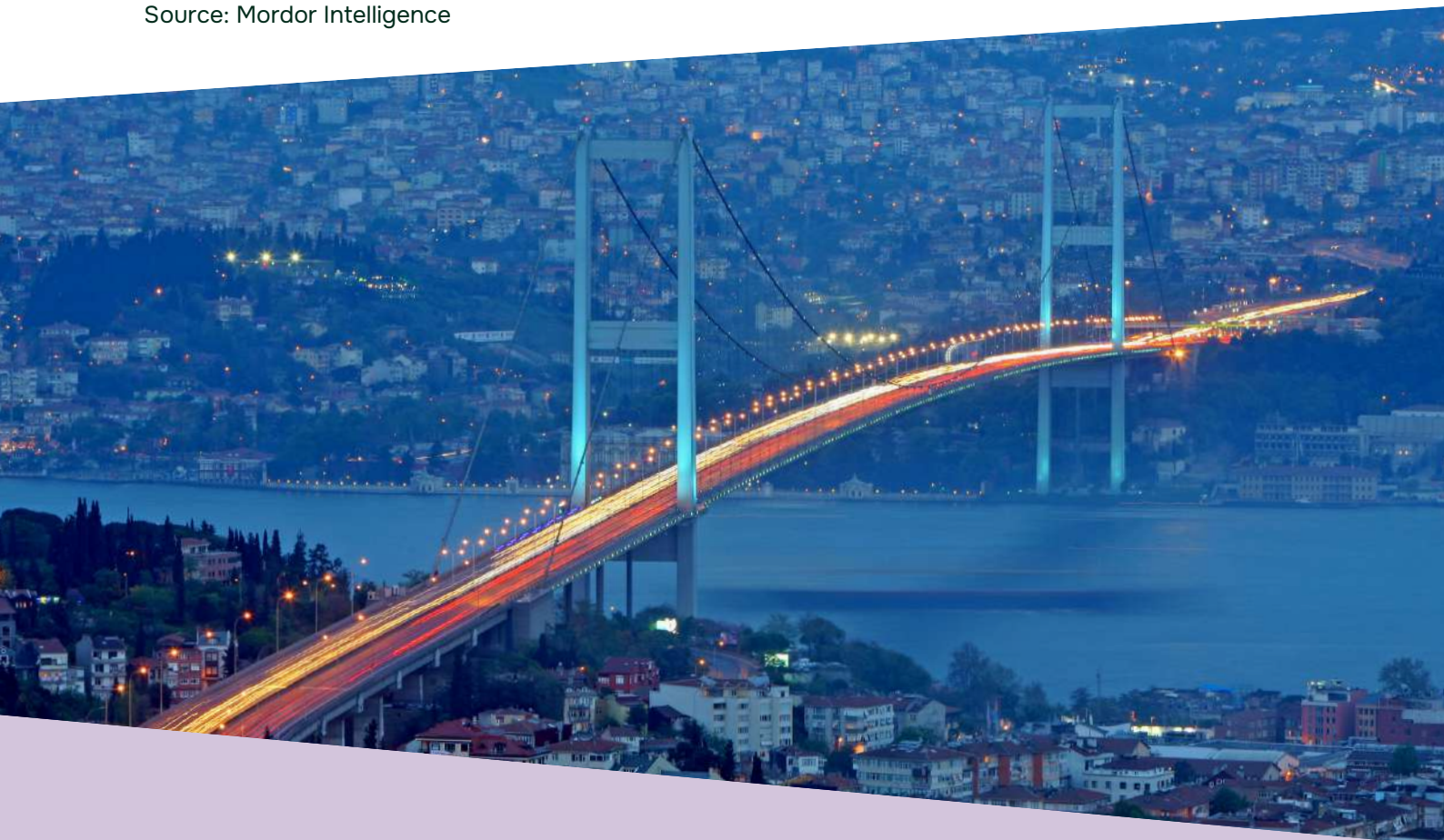

Türkiye's infrastructure sector is set for rapid expansion, projected to grow at a 7.03% CAGR through 2030. Supported by \$16.3 billion in planned transport investments for 2025, the country is advancing major highway extensions, high-speed rail lines and energy corridors that will reshape connectivity across Eurasia.

A \$46.2 billion public-investment programme, a robust PPP pipeline of 270 completed projects worth over \$204 billion, ongoing digital-construction and sustainability mandates are driving continuous project flow and foreign participation. With the national construction market forecast to reach \$226.99 billion by 2030, Türkiye offers unmatched prospects for companies supplying materials, technologies and expertise to the infrastructure value chain.
